

## STATEMENT ON EUROPEAN UNION DIRECTIVES CONCERNING RESTRICTION OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES (RoHS)

Steel Dynamics, Inc. – Roanoke Bar Division (SDI) is not regulated under RoHS for its domestic shipments of steel products, but understands that its customers may benefit from having this information. The information provided below is based on commercially reasonable efforts and applies to substances included as of the Policy date listed below. Concentration levels are based upon total weight of a homogenous material at the time products ship from SDI.

Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS Recast or RoHS 2) restricts the use of the following six hazardous substances in the manufacture of various types of electrical and electronic equipment at maximum concentration values tolerated by weight in homogeneous materials: lead -0.1%; mercury -0.1%; cadmium -0.01%; hexavalent chromium -0.1%; polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) -0.1%; and polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) -0.1%.

Effective July 22, 2019, Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 (RoHS 3) restricts the use of the following four additional hazardous substances: bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) -0.1%; butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) -0.1%; dibutyl phthalate (DBP) -0.1%; and diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) -0.1%.

To the best of SDI's knowledge and based upon information currently available, SDI's products do not contain any these ten substances above the relevant concentration or beyond the relevant scope of restriction.
